**8. MOTION ON OPENING UP OF ROAD NETWORKS**

**(BY HON. YARROW HASSAN)**

**THAT**, Aware that County Transport, including County Roads is the function of the County Government according to Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya; Further aware that many urban centers and rural areas in the County have very poor road network while others completely lack access roads; Worried that this poor and non-existent access roads will deny the people access to quick and quality basic services against the spirit of the provisions of Article 43 on the rights to economic and social rights; This County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee Member in charge of matters related to road in the county to come up with programme to open up access roads in areas all over the county and liaise with relevant National Government Agencies to improve status of road network within their jurisdiction.

## **9. MOTION BY HON. SUMEIYA BISHAR**

THAT, Aware that 35 per cent of the Kenya's population is below the age of 35 years; Further aware that the future of any County lies in the hands of its youths who are the greatest wealth and strength of any nation; Appreciating that the provisions of Article 55 of the Constitution of Kenya outlines the measures the state shall take to ensure the well-being of the youths is taken care of; Further appreciating that the development of village polytechnics and home craft centres is the function of the County Government according to the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya; Conscious that it will be a great wastage of human resources if these youths are not given an opportunity to harness and exploit their talent;; Concerned that the youths in the County are immensely affected by drug abuse especially of second generation alcoholic drink and Miraa which has a negatively impacted on their economic, social and political developments; this County Assembly urges the County Executive Committee member for Education, Culture and Social Services to expand the opportunities for increased access to youth polytechnics and home craft centers to offer viable alternative pathways to skills acquisition opportunities, since large number of primary and secondary education graduates do not transit to higher levels of learning.
